Why Become an SCQHA Queen Candidate?

- To represent and promote SCQHA Membership at local equestrian events and other venues, meeting and spending time with others that enjoy Quarter Horses as much as you.
- To be a friendly face and wealth of information to those who come to SCQHA meetings and horse shows.
- To be a role model for the SCQHA Youth Association.
- To hand out ribbons at the SCQHA Show and other Events throughout the year.
- To compete for Queen of the world's largest single breed horse show The All American Quarter Horse Congress



How do I become a 2023 SCQHA Queen Candidate?

- Join SCQHA in 2022 & 2023 as a Family, Single or Youth Member.
- Be 18 to 25 years of age (as of January 1, 2023) and not married, divorced, or a single parent
- Obtain a minimum of one \$25 sponsorship by June 2023 (Sponsorship Form Attached)
- Attend the annual meetings in 2022 and 2023.
- Mail in the **2023 Queen Application** with 3 **Wallet Sized Pictures** of the Candidate no later **than one week prior to** the annual Spooktacular show, which is held the last week in October (Please Note this date may be extended up to the competition if necessary by the Queen Advisor or Executive Committee)
- Attend the **2022 Annual Year End Awards Banquet** on the TBA date and assist as needed per the Queen Advisor. The winner will be announced after the meeting and prior to the Presentation of Awards.

How do I Compete to be the 2023 SCQHA Queen?

Complete the Queen Candidate requirements and Compete in the Queens contest for the Highest Final Combined Score:

- Personal Interview** (50% of Score) – **Friday October 28th** Time TBD, based on number of candidates and show schedule: There will be three interviewers, and you will be judged on your answers to their questions as well as your appearance, personality, and overall presentation. The Queen Advisor and/or at least one member of the Executive Committee will attend, but will not be a judge. You will be asked to answer questions regarding your knowledge of SCQHA and why you want the job of representing SCQHA as Queen. Queen attire is appropriate for this portion of the contest.
- Written Test** (30% of Score) - **Saturday, October 29th** written test will consist of questions on the current years AQHA rulebook of the following types: true and false, multiple choice, and fill in the blank. For all questions, candidates are advised to answer verbatim from the AQHA rulebook.



- Queen's Horsemanship** (20% of Score) – **Sunday, October 30th** at the SCQHA Horse Show. The exact class number will be included in the official show bill. You may ride any Quarter Horse you choose. The horse is not required to be owned by the candidate. The judges hired for the day will judge the class. The pattern used will be at the Queen Advisor's discretion.

In the event of a tie, the contestant with the highest personal interview will be crowned the winner since we feel that it is very important for our Queen to be well spoken in order to best represent the South Carolina Quarter Horse Association.

The winner will be announced at the annual SCQHA banquet, date TBA.

What Does SCQHA Provide for the 2023 Queen?

- All Members are encouraged to bring a gift to the incoming Queen at the Awards Banquet
- \$500 to use for Additional Queen Clothing and Incidentals
- 2023 Queen's personal webpage to post her bio, blog entries and pictures of the all the activities she completes throughout the year
- Her own hat crown, SCQHA sash, belt buckle
- A wealth of support and knowledge from former Queens, Professional Horsepersons, Seamstresses, business persons and Beauty Professionals dedicated to helping you navigate the knowledge, physical and financial demands of the 2023 Queen's Reign!!
- Other prizes will be dictated per year

What is expected of the 2023 Queen?

- Upon being crowned, the new Queen will be asked to sign the attached **Code of Conduct Agreement**. Should she refuse, the title will go to the first runner-up.



- Present 2022 Year End Awards at the Year End Awards Banquet after the Crowning Ceremony
- Attend the 2022 and 2023 SCQHA annual meetings, although attendance at all meetings is encouraged, and the 2023 SCQHVA Show.
- Present awards, promote membership and assist with the 2024 Queen's Contest at the 2023 SCQHA Spooktacular show in October 2023.
- Present awards at a minimum of 3 other shows, which may include SCQHA Shows, approved Quarter Horse shows, the South Carolina 4H State Horse Show, the Carolina Cup (contact Billy Prather), and other events may be proposed to the Queen Advisor for approval.
- Participate in the 2023 All American Quarter Horse Congress Queen's contest
- Pose in the 2023 SCQHA NYATT Team Picture at the All American Quarter Horse Congress if invited by the Youth Advisor
- Prepare a speech and participate in the crowning of the 2024 SCQHA Queen

While SCQHA pays for some of the Queen's expenses throughout the year, there are many expenses for which the Queen must raise funds. All monies raised by the Queen Candidates will be used to help fund expenses (hotel stays, gas money, advertising, etc.) for the 2023 Queen. Candidates are encouraged to obtain as many sponsors as possible. ALL Sponsors must be listed on the Website and ALL additional Queen fund raisers such as Raffles, Contests, Sales drives, Stakes Classes, etc. must be approved by the Executive Committee prior to committing.

If no applications are received by the deadline, there may be no SCQHA queen for the year for which the contest is run.

Should the title holder not comply with these rules, the membership may vote to strip her of her title, and reward title and all prizes won to the first runner up.

SCQHA Queen's Code of Conduct

The SCQHA Queen is a spokesperson and role model for the association. As Queen, I agree to abide by the following code of conduct:

- In order to represent SCQHA to the best of my ability, I agree to act at all times in a helpful, respectful, and dignified manner.
- I pledge to be helpful to all members, visitors and guests at SCQHA functions, including meetings, horse shows, and other activities.
- When I visit other horse shows as a representative of SCQHA, I will be punctual, friendly, and willing to assist with whatever is asked of me.
- Because I am a role model not only for the youth of my association, but of other youth members throughout the country, I agree to maintain a "clean" internet image.
- I will not post profane, obscene, or overly opinionated comments or photos on personal websites or group sites, such as but not limited to: Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and TikTok.
- I agree not to display images or comments condoning alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drug use.
- I agree not to consume alcohol, tobacco products, or illegal drugs when representing SCQHA at various functions, including horse shows, meetings, and at the All-American Quarter Horse Congress.

SCQHA encourages its Queens to maintain these standards at other public events as well, particularly those where AQHA members are likely to interact with them. Upon being crowned, the new Queen will be asked to sign this Code of Conduct. Should she refuse, the title will go to the first runner-up.

Upon the first violation of this Code, the Queen will receive a written warning from the Queen Advisor. Should further infractions occur, the SCQHA membership may vote to strip her of her title and all prizes won. The first runner-up will then assume the title and prizes.
